■ history



The amazing Parliament is one major sight of the city which also defines the wonderful landscape of the Danube river shore. It is the 3rd biggest Parliament building of the world and the second biggest in Europe after the London's Westminster Palace.

The 268 meter-long neo-Gothic building is constructed of more than 40 million bricks, 500,000 precious stones and nearly 90 pounds of gold. You can tour this magnificent structure. While the tours are fairly comprehensive, don't expect to see it all; there are 691 rooms and about 12 and a half miles of corridors within this seat of the National Assembly of Hungary.
